Key responsibilities:

- Review the strategic plan and provide recommendations for delivery.
- Engage with staff and volunteers to deepen knowledge of the Foodbank.
- Attend four meetings a year and read papers in preparation.
- Visit the Foodbank warehouse or other venues twice a year.
- Attend at least one of our key fundraising / supporters' events.
- Champion our work and be a spokesperson for us in the local community and other networks.

We would encourage applications from people with lived experience, people with experience of volunteering with the food bank, existing supporters of the food bank, local community representative, referral agencies and faith representatives.
